Planned Care is an operation or treatment which you have known about for some time.

and the

 Royal Shrewsbury Hospital becomes a Planned Care place



Both hospitals would have an **Urgent Care** Centre that is open all day and night, every day.



Urgent Care is where you need help straight away - but you are not likely to die.
